(But I do hope that we run very close to this schedule – with everyone's help, WE WILL!)**

### **Age divisions are as follows:**

Kids - 5 to 10 year olds; Teens - 11 to 16 year olds; Adults - 17 and older

### **Patterns Competition**

Patterns are judged on technical correctness (facing, loads, timing, power, etc.). ONLY Ch'ang Han Patterns will qualify for medal winners; non-Ch'ang Han patterns may compete, but will lose by default.

Color belts will call their own rank-appropriate pattern, but may compete with a previous pattern if they tested within one month prior to competition. Red stripes and below may ask to restart their pattern with no deductions but must follow protocol (come to attention, raise their hand and ask to restart their pattern) to do so. Red belts and above MAY NOT restart their patterns.

Black Belts will have one designated and one optional pattern. Both patterns count for determination of the winner. Black Belts may not restart their patterns. Patterns competition are Single Elimination.

### **Sparring Competition**

Kids (5 to 10 year olds) will run a 1 1/2 minute sparring match. Teens (11 to 16 year olds) and adults (17 and older) will run 2 minutes. Black Belts will run two (2) two-minute rounds.

All appropriate sparring gear must be worn by ALL COMPETITORS!! No open-hand gloves.

One point for hand techniques to the body; two points for foot techniques to the body; three points for foot techniques to the head. Paper score sheets will be used for scoring, so judges, pay attention to the match! In case of tie, a one minute subsequent round will be played. A further tie will be decided by a "Sudden Death" final match. Sparring matches are Single Elimination rounds.

### **Board-breaking (white pine #2 wood will be used)**

Open to green belts and above. NO hand techniques for Junior competitors ages 14 and younger.

Foot technique – Side kick; hand technique – Inward or Outward Knife-hand strike.

In case of a tie, competitors will execute same kick, other leg, or same hand technique, other hand. A subsequent tie will call for a turning kick and/or a straight punch. One point for each broken board; 1/2 point for cracked – not broken – board.

Black Belts have a two board minimum for hand break and a three board minimum for foot break.

Grand Champion Trophies will be awarded for Black Belts competing in ALL THREE EVENTS and achieving the highest total scores. Scores are one point for 3rd place, 3 points for 2nd place and 5 points for 1st place.

### **Continuous Kicking Challenge**

All ranks can participate. There are four (4) divisions in this event: white belts to green stripes; green belts to blue belts; red stripes to black stripes; and black belts. There are three (3) categories: IDD/MHMR (Special Needs), Adults 13 and over, and Juniors 12 and younger. Competitors will kick a stand-up bag with a kick of their choice and the competitor with the most kicks wins. Once the competitor puts their foot down, the kick

count will stop. There will be no time limit on kicking as long as the kicking is continuous and as long as kicks are delivered within 3 seconds of the last kick. IF A COMPETITOR DOES NOT DELIVER A SUBSEQUENT KICK WITHIN 3 SECONDS OF THE LAST KICK, THE KICK COUNT WILL STOP. Boys may compete against girls, and men against women. **Each kick must have a correct load (chamber), must utilize the correct kicking tool, and must make contact with the target in order to be counted. Special Needs competitors must (only) make contact with the target, load and kicking tool notwithstanding.** This event will not count towards the Grand Champion Title. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place medals will be awarded in this event.

### **Hotel Accommodations**

### **General Information**

We will run three rings (kids, teens and adults) for Patterns and Sparring both. Advanced ranks (red belts and above) may help with corner judging. Junior Black Belts **will have an opportunity** to Center Referee for the Kids divisions. A higher rank Adult Black Belt will be present to mentor the Junior Black Belt. Any questionable calls by the Center Referee (Junior Black Belt) will be deferred to the higher rank adult Black Belt for final determination of the call in question.

Concessions (water, soft drinks, snacks) will be available for sale. No entrance fees are charged for spectators.
